"Welcome to the Nepal Peace Trust Fund (NPTF) website.

The NPTF is a funding instrument of the Government of Nepal (GoN) and a group of donors – European Union (EU), United States Agency for International Development (USAID), Department for International Development (DFID), Germany, Switzerland, Norway, Denmark and Finland. It was created to support critical peace activities and the implementation of the Comprehensive Peace Accord (CPA), and other peace-related agreements. The Fund was established in January 2007 and has so far managed NPR 23 billion for supporting 67 projects. The GoN contributes 60 per cent of the Fund, and the Donor Group 40 per cent.



In 2014/15 five donors (DFID, Norway, Denmark, Finland and Switzerland) decided not to continue support to the Fund; Germany had already decided not to continue the support to focus on other national priorities. Thereafter the GoN and two donors, the EU and USAID, have been supporting the NPTF.

The NPTF is now in its third phase. Its work during this period will be guided by a new strategy (2014-17) where it would support programmes and projects in four clusters: Cluster one Social Dimensions/ Conflict Affected Peoples (CAPs), Cluster 2: Transitional Justice and Reconciliation, Cluster 3: Access to Security, and Cluster 4: Political dimension.

This website is an attempt to inform stakeholders about the NPTF and the projects and programmes it has undertaken and plans to undertake in its third phase. The site contains strategic documents, reports, publications and other information related to the NPTF.
