

Project Title: 0303 - Police Units Reconstruction Project (Phase II)

Name of Implementing Agency: PHQ and its 72 District Police Offices (DPOs)

Collaborating Agency (ies): Ministry of Home Affairs (MOHA) and local communities

Status of the Project: Ongoing

Duration: September 2011 to March 2013

Location: 72 districts

Beneficiaries: NP and entire population of the area

Total Project Budget: NP 4,224,822,000 of which NPTF will finance NPR 3,776,822,000.00; and NPR 224,000,000.00 each by the NP and public participation.



Description:

- A total of 768 police units were destroyed / damaged during the decade long conflict in the country, which had compelled Nepal Police (NP) to resume services using mostly rented properties, which are obviously not decent as well as vulnerable from security point of view. This has made it urgent to re-establish the police units by undertaking gender friendly reconstructions to enable the police units to immediately respond to the security needs of the local people. The Phase II builds upon the successes and lessons learned from the first phase of reconstruction of police units project.

Goal:

Improved quality of services of the police units at the local level through the reconstructed and well equipped offices.

Purpose:

- To undertake gender friendly reconstruction of the police units that were destroyed/ damaged during the conflict period

Major Achievements:

- Design, cost estimates and preparation of bidding materials for Phase II reconstruction are in the final stages/near completion stages.
- Procurement process to invite contractors to bid is in the process.

Note: as the project is at the initial implementation stages, the outcomes and issues are not yet evident.
