**Description:**

The project aims to establish and strengthen the coordination mechanisms led by MoPR for effective implementation of UNSCRs 1325 & 1820 NAP in close coordination with key implementing ministries. At the district level, mobilisation of the District Coordination Committees (DCCs) is enhanced to function as the conduit between central and community level for effective NAP implementation. Capacity enhancement of MoPR Gender Unit and related officials as well as key Ministries, DCCs and line agencies will be simultaneously undertaken to achieve the project objectives. The project also includes a media outreach and communication plan to facilitate promotion of public awareness to enhance the understanding for ensuring women's participation at different levels of peace building and conflict transformation and CAW&G's improved access to justice, relief and recovery programs.
