



Title of the project: Police Units Reconstruction Project Phase-III

Context:

A total of 768 police units were destroyed/damaged during the decade long conflict in the country, which had compelled Nepal Police to resume from mostly rented properties, which are obviously not decent as well as vulnerable security concerns. Thus, there is necessity to re-establish the police units by undertaking gender friendly reconstructions to enable the police units to immediately respond to the security needs of the local people. On one hand, there is growing demands to reconstruct the destroyed/damaged police units while on the other there are no Government funds made available for the purposes. It will be a collaborative effort to arrange technical and financial contribution and also engagement of the local people/community and the NP in the project. This project will also build on the similar approach of implementation and management as during the first phase, which was financed by the Nepal Peace Trust Fund.

Goal:

Improved quality of services of the police units at the local level through the reconstructed equipped offices

Purpose:

To undertake gender friendly reconstruction of the 77 police units that were destroyed/ damaged during the conflict period.

Output:

- Physical facilities of the NP are improved at the local levels.

Activities:

1. Reconstruction of police units
2. Reconstruction of compound wall fencing, internal road etc
3. Providing technical manpower and training
4. Procurement of Equipment & (3D max, SAP etc.)
5. Evaluation Administration
